

The following are the agreed remuneration rates for board members with effect from 1 January 2020. They have been increased by 2.2% - RPI for the 12 months to December 2019:

Chair

- The remuneration of the Chair is £35,740 per annum for a commitment of 50 days.
- A daily rate of £714 will be paid for each additional day.

Board

- The remuneration of board members is £3,920 per annum for a commitment of 7 Board meetings and the associated preparation and occasional correspondence in between those meetings.
- Where any additional attendance is requested, a further daily rate of £392 based on a 7-hour day will be paid (pro rata in hourly units for part days).
- Where any board member is requested by the Chair to represent the IPReg at events a sum of £196 may be claimed.

Complaints Review Committee

- The three board members sitting as a Complaints Review Committee will each be paid £392 per day (pro rata for part days based on a 7-hour day).
- Normally a maximum of 0.5 days reading time will be paid for each scheduled case. However, if a case is particularly complex, the relevant CRC members can increase the allocated preparation time if they agree that half a day is not sufficient.

General

- Each year, the Board will consider adjusting these rates annually with effect from 1 January by the then RPI.
- Travel time will not be paid for attendance at meetings in London.
